A Typical Day

Activities will include some of the following:

- Soccer baseball, water games, team building games, baseball, road hockey, parachute games, relay races, (rain or shine games prepared)

Dropping Off

Parents are responsible for dropping their children off at the church building between 8:45 and 9:30. At this time the children will be welcomed and also given the opportunity to have a nutritional breakfast. Coffee will be provided for the parents. As well, parents are encouraged to stick around and help out if they wish.

Picking Up

Parents are responsible for picking up their children between 3:00-3:30. If someone else (other than a parent) is going to be picking up the children this must be told to the directors of the camp at drop off. The campers will only be allowed to leave camp with those whom we have been authorized to send the campers home with.

Volunteers

The summer camp is being staffed by the Newmarket Church of Christ and friends. Each volunteer has been asked to attend the Newmarket Church of Christ's class on protecting children from abuse. As well, each volunteer over the age of 18 that will be a supervisor or activity leader is being asked to provide a police check or three references. At this time the church is recruiting volunteers who have been trained in the medical field to provide on-site medical attention if the need arises.

We welcome parents of children to volunteer at the camp. Volunteers will be needed to help serve breakfast, lunch and snacks as well as helping with the organization and implementation of various activities throughout the day.

Who Is the Newmarket Church of Christ?

The Newmarket Church of Christ grew out of a vision of specific families living in York Region to plant a church in a fast growing neighborhood, now known as the Longford subdivision. In its beginning years the church rented Maple Leaf Public School on Sunday's. As the church grew in size a piece of property (230 Davis Dr. – south side of Davis just down from Tim Horton's) was purchased and a building was built.

Over the years the Newmarket Church of Christ has sought to reconnect with the neighborhood's in which it resides. With this a community garden was established for the seniors living in the high rise condominiums. As well the church has sought ways to connect with the Longford subdivision through various initiatives: each week thirty lunches are provided for Maple Leaf Public School to help feed children in the neighborhood and a group of people participate in a reading program in which volunteers help children further their reading skills.

The Newmarket Church of Christ is a group of people that seeks to live their lives centered around Jesus Christ. As we center our lives around Jesus we are called to serve others. It is our wish that we might continue to learn how to serve our neighborhoods.

Friday Barbecue
